Official Exam Rules

- You must be in school and ready to start the exams at 8.30AM for the morning and 1.30PM for the afternoon exams. If you are late, you will **not** be given extra time.
- You need to arrive 30 minutes before the start of your exam. You may bring a **bottle of water**. This must be a clear bottle with **no** wrapping.
 - Students will not be allowed out of the exam venues to drink water.
- Please ensure that you bringS the right equipment, e.g., scientific calculator for Science & Maths papers.
- A black pen must be used for all papers including rulers and pencils for graphs and drawings
- Pencil cases must be transparent / clear only
- Toilet breaks don't ask! Make sure you go before the exam On average 4 6 minutes is lost. You will **not** be given the time back.
- Mobile phones must be turned off and placed in the plastic wallet. A student caught with a
 mobile phone will be reported to the Exam Board. This will result in disqualification.
- **NO WATCHES are allowed in the Exam Hall** they must be placed in the wallets provided. A student caught with a watch or smart watch will be reported to the Exam Board. This will result in **disqualification**.
- Other products with text/digital facilities must be placed in the wallet. A student caught with any electronic product will be reported to the Exam Board. This will result in disqualification.
- NO calculator cases or extra bits of paper attached. This will result in disqualification.
- Full School Uniform including shoes and belts (Year 11)/smart attire (6th Form) must be worn at all times with no exception.
- You MUST ATTEND EVERY Exam stated on your timetable
- If there are extenuating circumstances which occur around the time of your exam you must inform the school **immediately**. Extra time may be given.
- Exams cannot be taken at a later date but we can help.

CONTACT THE SCHOOL IMMEDIATELY IF.....

- Fractured/Broken or sprained leg or hand a doctors note must be provided
- You become extremely ill on the day of the exam
- o If there is a bereavement please notify us immediately
