Ramadan Mubarak to all Muslim parents and families.

I am writing to let you know that on Monday 3rd March we will be at the start of the holy month of Ramadan. At the request of Student Leadership, staff have agreed to give up half of their lunch time, to facilitate a later start during Ramadan. All lessons will still be of the same length so learning time will not be reduced.

Therefore, all students will need to be in school by **9:00am** for registration each day (starting on Monday 3rd March 2025 until Friday 28th March).

School will finish at the normal time each day and students will still be **expected to attend any additional classes or interventions.**
