**Re: School Uniform Expectations for Female Students**

I hope this letter finds you well. At Mulberry Stepney Green, we are committed to maintaining high standards in all areas of school life, including uniform. Our uniform policy is designed to promote a sense of identity, equality, and pride in our school community.

As we begin the new term, I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the expectations around uniform for female students.

We ask for your continued support in ensuring that your child comes to school each day wearing the correct uniform. This enables all students to focus on their learning without unnecessary distractions or issues arising from incorrect attire. **Trousers** must be:

- Plain black, Straight cut, medium width, regular fit or pleated, may have turn-ups, shoe length
- **No fashion styles including:**
  - 'Boot leg'
  - 'Ski pants'
  - 'Flared' trousers
  - Jeans or denim-style fabric
  - No lycra

We kindly ask that you avoid purchasing fashion trousers that do not meet these criteria. Students wearing trousers that do not adhere to this policy will be sent home to get changed and parents will be contacted.

We believe that consistency in uniform helps reinforce our values of discipline and unity.
