RE: Ramadan Timings

Ramadan Mubarak to all Muslim parents and families.

I am writing to let you know that we will have our 1 week half term holidays from Monday 16th February to Friday 20th February, students return to school on Monday 23rd February. Also we will be at the start of the holy month of Ramadan when we return on 23rd February 2026.

At the request of Student Leadership, staff have agreed to give up half of their lunch time, to facilitate **a later start during Ramadan**. All lessons will still be of the same length so learning time will not be lost.

Therefore, all students will need to be in school by **9:00am** for registration each day (starting on Monday 23rd February 2026 until 19th March 2026).

School will finish at the normal time each day and students will still be **expected to attend any additional classes or interventions**.
